CAA Free Balloon Pilots Licences/BAFSA Membership

Several pilots have already received their new card licences from the CAA and the rest will receive these as their licences are renewed.

The new card licences are valid for 2 years from date of issue.

It remains a requirement under the CAR's that all pilots are to be BAFSA members to ensure the full validity of their licences.

The Committee has elected to maintain BAFSA membership on an annual basis (expires on 31 December)

Should any active pilots fail to renew their membership by 28/02/22, the BAFSA Committee will consider advising CAA to suspend your licence.
